CCF celebrated ICCD by organising activities in the hospitals based on the following theme:

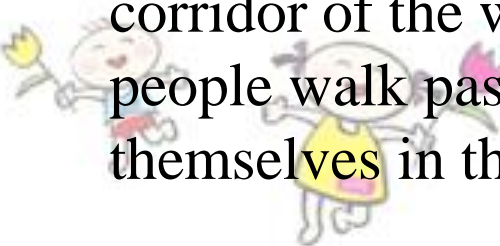
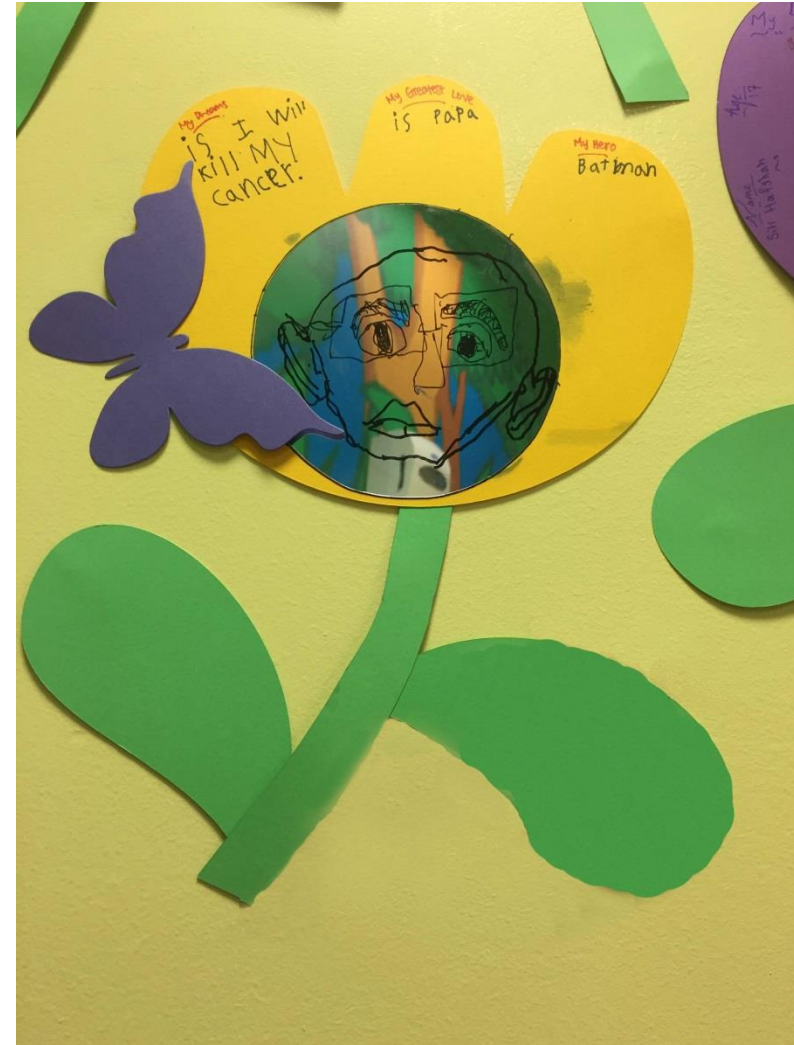
“I have cancer but I am still ME”
